What can you do at home?

1. Please practise reading and writing the high frequency words.
2. Please practise writing words containing four sounds.
3. Practise reading and writing phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs.
4. Practise adding and subtracting within 10.
5. Practise counting in twos and tens. Practise number formation.
6. Practise writing a sentence or two with clear finger spaces and capital letters and full stops
