Phonics Phonic focus for this week

 $ee_{ur} \circ w$ why au This week we will be working on cvc+ combinations including polysyllabic words. We will learn to read the high frequency words- made, make and came.

English and Topic

We will be continuing our fact writing about minibeasts.

<u>Maths</u>

This week we will be re-capping addition and subtraction. We will use objects and number lines to help us.

What can you do at home?

- 1. Please practise reading and writing the high frequency words.
- 2. Practise reading and writing phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs
- 3. Please listen to/read with your child and make comments in the reading record. Please keep this in their book bags each day as we regularly check these and update them.
- 4. Practise adding and taking away using objects or a number line up to 10/20 or beyond.
- 5. Practise counting in twos to 20 and number bonds to 5/10.
- 6. Practise doubling numbers up to 10 and halving numbers by sharing objects practically.
- 7. Practise sentence writing. Find a picture of anything that interests your child in a magazine or on the internet and ask your child to write about it. Try to do this 2 or 3 times a week.

Action points

★Show and Tell - Group 3 Friday 21st June. The theme is to design and make a simple maths game.

★For the last Show and Tell- There is no theme and the children can bring in anything to show. (It cannot be too large or too precious.)_Your child needs to bring the item, which could be something they made or an item they have, and they need to write a sentence to explain why they chose to bring the particular item / why they like it. Group 1 – Friday 28th June, Group 2 – Friday 5th July, Group 3 – Friday 12th July.

★ <u>Sports Day</u> - Monday 17th June, your child needs to be dropped off at Stovell Field between 8.45am and 8.55am. They need to wear a plain T-shirt in their house colour. ★ Class Assembly - Tuesday 18^{th} June, 9am at St Stephen and St Agnes Church.
