This week in Reception

This week we will thinking about 'Light and Colour' and for our focus we will use the book 'Brown Bear, Brown Bear, what do you see?

Phonics

Phonic focus for this week

This week we will introduce the sounds/ graphemes 'ss', 'l', 'll'. We will use Monster wh y au Phonic actions and songs to help support the learning. We will introduce the tricky words- he, she, we.

Maths

This week we will be starting the White Rose unit- 1,2,3,4,5. In addition we will be finding and recording data in a bar chart linked to colour. We will also be ordering and sorting objects according to their size.



What can you do at home?

- 1. Please help your child practise the sounds and make sure the sound book is in their book bag the following Thursday so the new sounds
- 2. Practise reading the tricky words we have covered. Mini flashcards are at the back of your child's sound book and you can look for the tricky words in books.
- 3. Reading books and reading records have been given out. Please listen to/read with your child and make comments in the reading record. Please keep this in their book bags each day as we regularly check them and your child may read in school on a different day each week.
- 4. Keep practising name writing using the school script and other letters, in particular 'c,a,d,g' as we are focusing on them in class.
- 5. Look for 2D shapes in the environment. Practise naming them and describing them. Focus on square, rectangle, triangle, circle and then hexagon, semi-circle, pentagon.

Action points

- ★Show & Tell this Friday, 21st November is for Group 2 and the theme is 2D shapes. The children could go on a shape hunt and take photos, make a shape mobile or draw a shape picture. Be as creative as you like. The children need to be able to name the shapes- square, rectangle, circle, triangle etc- and describe them, (number of sides and corners.) Group 3 will be on Friday 28th November. Please note there will be no show and tell on December 5th, due to the Christingle service.
- ★Please send in any spare paper/ plastic cups you may have for an activity on Thursday.
- ★ BLOG- Last Friday, 14th November, was our turn to post our blog on the school website. Each class posts about once a half term. It can be found at the bottom of the homepage. It is a great way to see what the children have been learning.
