# Phonics Phonic focus for this week

This week we will continue phase 4, reading and spelling CVCC words and high wh y au frequency words. We will learn the phase 4 tricky words 'do' and 'when'.

## **English and Topic**

We will be writing information books about farm animals. The children will be encouraged to write more than one sentence using school writing, clear finger spaces and full stops.

#### Maths

This week will be recapping positional language and giving directions, linking it to farm maps. We will also be re-capping re-calling number bonds to 10.

### What can you do at home?

- 1. Please practise reading and writing the high frequency words.
- 2. Practise reading and writing phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs
- 3. Please listen to/read with your child and make comments in the reading record. Please keep this in their book bags each day as we regularly check these and update them.
- 4. Practise doubling numbers up to 10 using objects and sharing up to 20 objects into two groups.
- 5. Share information books and practise finding information. Can your child use the contents page?
- 6. Practise sentence writing. Find a picture of anything that interests your child in a magazine or on the internet and ask your child to write about it. Try to do this 2 or 3 times a week.

- ★Show and tell is for group 3 on Friday. The theme is favourite animals. Please can your child draw, paint or make a model of their chosen animal and write two or three sentences / facts about
- ★Please ensure that your child has a named water bottle in school every day.
- ★Please remember to bring library books on Tuesday. .
