This week in Maths we will introduce the idea of estimating and will practise counting objects. On Friday we will practise forming the numbers 1,2,3 correctly.

What can you do at home?

1. We will be sending a sound book home on Thursday with the sounds we have learnt during the

week. Please help your child practise the sounds and make sure the sound book is in their book bag the following Thursday so the new sounds can be stuck in.

2. Practise estimating and counting objects up to 10/20.

3. Keep practising dressing and undressing independently, including turning inside out sleeves and trouser legs etc.
