English and Topic

We will be talking about our favourite pet and writing a list of pets. We will also be learning about Queen Elizabeth II, learning about her Coronation and writing a simple sentence about it, using the correct punctuation.

Maths

This week we will be counting in ones, twos and tens. We will revisit 2D shape. We will name common shapes- circle, square, rectangle, triangle, hexagon, octagon, pentagon, - and describe their properties.

What can you do at home?

- 1. Please practise reading and writing the high frequency words.
- 2. Practise reading and writing phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs
- 3. Please listen to/read with your child and make comments in the reading record. Please keep this in their book bags each day as we regularly check these and update them.
- 4. Practise adding and taking away using objects or a number line up to 10/20 or beyond.
- 5. Practise counting in twos to 20 and tens to a hundred
- 6. Practise sentence writing. Find a picture of anything that interests your child in a magazine or on the internet and ask your child to write about it. Try to do this 2 or 3 times a week.

Action points

★There will be no show and tell this week as Friday is an INSET day. Group 1 show and tell will be on Friday 10th June. The theme is favourite pet or animal. Please can the children draw, paint or make a model of their chosen animal and write two or three sentences / facts about it. \star Please ensure that your child has a named water bottle in school every day.

★Please remember to bring library books on Tuesday.
