

This week in Reception

This week we will be learning about rainforests and the animals that live there. We will be thinking about the following questions - Are all the minibeasts the same or different? What other animals live there and where are the rainforests?

Phonics Phonic focus for this week

This week we will be working on cvc+ combinations including polysyllabic words such as sandpit, lunchbox. We will learn to read the high frequency words- I'm, very, old. wh y au

English and Topic

This week the children will be completing different independent writing activities linked to the Rainforest.

Maths

This week we will be continuing and creating repeated patterns. We will also re-cap addition. subtraction and number bonds.

What can you do at home?

- 1. Please practise reading and writing the high frequency words.
- 2. Practise reading and writing phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs
- 3. Please listen to/read with your child and make comments in the reading record. Please keep this in their book bags each day as we regularly check these and update them.
- 4. Practise adding and taking away using objects or a number line up to 10/20 or beyond.
- 5. Practise counting in twos to 20 and number bonds to 5/10.
- 6. Practise doubling numbers up to 10 and halving numbers by sharing objects practically.
- 7. Practise sentence writing. Find a picture of anything that interests your child in a magazine or on the internet and ask your child to write about it. Try to do this 2 or 3 times a week.

Action points

★Show and Tell- There is no theme and the children can bring in anything to show. (It cannot be too large or too precious.) Your child needs to bring the item, which could be something they made or an item they have, and they need to write a sentence to explain why they chose to bring the particular item / why they like it. Group 1 – Friday 28th June, Group 2 – Friday 5th July, Group 3 – Friday 12th July.

Swimming – All the children had a great first swimming lesson, well done. Please make sure your child has their swimming costume on under their uniform and they have their swimming bag with a towel, swim hat and underwear. Please don't send flip flops or crocs as they don't need these.
