This week in Reception

This week we are introducing our new topic 'All about minibeasts'.

Phonics Phonic focus for this week

this week we will continue phase 4, reading and spelling CVCC words and high frequency words. Our new tricky words are **'out' and 'what'**.

English and Topic

The children will be writing lists of mini-beasts and writing about their favourite mini-beast. The focus will be on the children writing independently.

<u>Maths</u>

This week we will revisit 2d and 3d shapes, practise counting beyond 20, count in 2s, 5s and 10s and we will also be looking at shape and number patterns.

What can you do at home?

- 1. Please practise reading and writing the high frequency words.
- 2. Practise reading and writing phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs
- 3. Sort books into story and information books. Do all information books have a contents page? Practise using the contents page.
- 4. Practise adding and taking away using objects or a number line up to 10/20 or beyond.
- 5. Practise counting in twos to 20 and tens to a hundred.

Action points

Show and Tell- As each group only has one more turn before the end of the school year, there is no theme and the children can bring in anything to show. (It cannot be too large or too precious.) Your child needs to bring the item, which could be something they made or an item they have **and they need to write a sentence to explain why they chose to bring the particular item**. This Friday will be group 1's turn, next Friday 8th will be group 2 and group 3 will show on Friday 15th.
