Phonic focus for this week

This week we will be introducing the sounds 'p', 'n', 'c, k' & 'e'. We will use Jolly Phonic actions and songs to help support the learning.

Maths

This week in Maths we will be working on counting, recognising and ordering numbers to 10/20/30. We will also practise forming numerals correctly.



What can you do at home?

1. Please help your child practise the sounds and make sure the sound book is in their book bag this Thursday so the new sounds can be stuck in.
2. Practise counting and reading numbers to 10/20 or beyond.
3. Keep practising name writing using the school script and encourage your child to use a 'snappy fingers' triangular pencil grip.
