## Year 3

**Maths** – we will continue to work on fractions this week. We will be finding unit fractions and non-unit fractions of small numbers.

**English** – We are continuing to practise writing letters and will write a persuasive letter this week. We are then going to take part in an initiative organised by the Times Educational Supplement called Classrooms to Care Homes. This is aimed at alleviating some of the isolation and loneliness found in our care homes at the moment due to the Covid restrictions through children writing Christmas themed letters to the residents of care homes. If they would like to include a Christmas joke or poem then they could look some up over the next few days and bring them in towards the end of the week. We will be posting them to one or two local care homes at the beginning of December. I have made contact with a couple of local homes to see if they are happy to take part, but if anyone has a request for a particular home, perhaps where you know a resident, then do let me know as soon as possible.

**Spellings** – the spelling this week is focussed on words which have an apostrophe to mark missing letters.

**Foundation subjects** – In science we are continuing to investigate different forces. In RE we are continuing to look at the meaning of Christmas for Christians. Our PE lessons are being provided by Mr Hawkes on Fridays and the Windsor Sports Partnership on Tuesday in a Dance session and Wednesday in the classroom looking at Healthy Minds. We are looking at the importance of the River Nile in History.

## **Design Technology Lessons**

We are going to have a DT day on Monday November 16<sup>th</sup> and attempt to do the whole pneumatic model project in a day. We will be planning and designing it, making the model and evaluating it before taking it home at the end of the day.

The children will need a selection of small junk modelling cardboard boxes such as toothpaste boxes, Oxo boxes, boxes from cereal bars etc. **but only if they did not contain nuts** and perhaps one or two slightly larger boxes such as a small cereal or shoe box.
