Our learning this week:

Maths – we will be looking at multiplication and starting to use a written method for the first time. It is called the grid method and I will put up a video on the Abacus page so that you can see how we do it.

English – We have heard every child read this week and have assessed the childrens' current reading levels based on their comprehension of the reading text as well as their fluency. The children will bring home reading books on Monday.

In lessons we will be working on non-chronological reports based on our work in Geography about South America. First of all we are working on the technique of recording information using notes instead of full sentences and then we will be writing the different paragraphs for our reports.

Spellings – prefix -super

Foundation subjects – In science we will be looking at muscles. In geography we will continue to look at the different physical features of South America and start to think about human features. Our RE lessons will now focus on the Easter Story for Christians and our question 'What is good about Good Friday?' Having looked at Palm Sunday last week, we will now look at the Last Supper. Mr Hawkes will be teaching PE on Fridays and I will be teaching it on Tuesday afternoons. Mr Murray will be here on Tuesday for our first trombone lesson.

Homework this week:

For the rest of this term we will be focussing on spelling, reading and learning times tables for homework.

Spellings: This week the spellings are using the prefix –super. They will be tested on Friday.
