Our learning this week:

Maths – we will be revising what we have learned before about fractions and then moving on with finding equivalent fractions and fractions of amounts. We will also look at counting in tenths and ordering fractions on a number line.

English – We will be researching a South American animal to write a report about. We will be using notes to record information before writing the report. The focus will be on using paragraphs to organise information. We will also work on handwriting, especially the join from a letter 'r' into other letters.

Spellings – words with the prefix -auto

Foundation subjects – In science we will complete this topic by using our knowledge of skeletons and muscles to design a new vertebrate. In geography we will learn about what products we use that come from South America. Our RE lessons are focussing on the Easter Story and our question 'What is good about Good Friday?' Having looked at the Last Supper last week, we will now look at what happened on Good Friday and its meaning for Christians. Mr Murray will be here on Tuesday for our next trombone lesson and we will also be taking part in a body percussion workshop via Zoom on Thursday with a percussion teacher from Berkshire Maestros. In our computing lesson we will be learning to use spread sheets.

Homework this week:

For the rest of this term we will be focussing on spelling, reading and learning times tables for homework.
