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Our learning this week:

Maths – We will now move onto multiplication and division. We will be multiplying 2-digit numbers by 1 digit numbers using the grid method and using multiplication facts to divide.

English – This week we will be continuing to convert a well-known traditional tale into a play script. We have planned each scene and will write a description of the setting before writing the dialogue and adding stage directions.

Foundation subjects – Our science lesson will look at how rocks are formed. In RE we are looking at how Sikhs share through 'seva' – service to others in the context of the Vaisakhi festival. Mr Murray will be here on Tuesday for another trombone lesson. In our computing lesson we will be continuing to learn to use spread sheets. In Geography we will look at the structure of volcanoes.
