# Our learning this week:

**Maths** – We are continuing with multiplication and division. We are working on dividing numbers using our times table facts and will look at calculations with remainders. We are using number lines to help and will not move onto 'bus stop' division until Year 4.

**English** – This week we are finishing the writing of our play script and will edit them having acted them out to help us make any changes to content. We will also look at the grammar of exclamations.

**Foundation subjects** – Our science lesson will look at igneous, sedimentary and igneous rocks. In RE we are looking the Guru Granth Sahib, the Holy book of the Sikhs, and the instruction to share. Mr Murray will be here on Tuesday for another trombone lesson. In our computing lesson we will be looking at internet safety. In Geography we will look at the effects of volcanic eruptions and look at why people live near them. In Art we will be continuing to make our sea themed collage.
