




This is harder than it sounds....

The project's final writing task is to write the story of The Tempest in just 100 words... YES! You read correctly- just 100 words! How you do this is totally up to you but...

### Our advice:

- Watch back each of the story tellings from each week
- Make brief notes as you watch each week (you can use the planning template provided)
- Write your first attempt- don't worry too much about the number of words at this point
- When you've finished, count how many words you've used
- Go back from the beginning and start to cross out extra words that you don't need to have, for example;
  - "Ariel, a magic sprite" could become "magical Ariel"
- Remember using apostrophes in contractions will help get your word count down!
- You will likely have to write it at least 4 or 5 times to be able to do it!
  - See how close you can get whilst still telling the story!
- Y Once you're done, think about how you may publish it-as a little book, a poster or a filmed story telling for others to watch
