This week in Year 3

English:

In English, we will finish writing our own version of Jim and the beanstalk and then edit our sentences to make sure we have included all the key features.

Maths:

This week we will build on our knowledge of column method and begin to exchange our 1s, 10s and 100s to help us add and subtract across 10s and 100s.

Homework:

Homework this week consists of one English and one maths piece of work. The English is revision of how to use inverted commas and punctuate them correctly.

In maths, the children have been given worksheets using column addition and column subtraction without exchanging columns.

Please allow time for reading; at least ten minutes every day (5 times at least) and 5-10 minutes times tables and number bond practice using TTRockstars and Numbots.

Reading diaries are collected in and checked on a Friday and golden points are awarded for children that have at least read 5x a week and had their diary signed.

Please feel free to read your own reading books at home. The school books are set at your child's level so please read those often but enjoy a range of genres and stories together as part of your daily routine.

Spellings:

This week the tricks/ patterns needed to help learn the words focus on the grapheme "ou" or "ow" sound.

The list of words to learn are; ground, power, howl, owl, tower, flower, count, found, sound, pound

They will be tested on this list of words next **Monday 17th November**. Children in our class are given different spellings so if they lose their list, please ask an adult from the Yr 3 team and we will happily provide you with a new list.

Other Matters:

- Please make sure the correct PE kit is in school for our lessons on a Wednesday and Friday. They will need shorts for indoor PE and leggings or jogging bottoms for outside as well as the usual t-shirt and PE jumper and socks which should all be named.
