English: This week, we will continue our learning on dictionaries. We will be using dictionaries to check spellings and thesauruses to search for alternative words.

Homework:

The homework sent home on Friday consisted of some sentence work in English and, in Maths, a worksheet on column subtraction with exchanges across a 10. Ten minutes reading and 5-10 minutes times tables and number bond practice should also form part of your child's daily routine.

Spellings:

In the test on **Wednesday 12th January** most children will be tested on words from the National Curriculum List for Y3/4: length, strength, purpose, history, different, difficult, separate, suppose, therefore and knowledge.

<u>New spellings</u> will be sent out after the test. These will be Star Colour Spellings which are specific to each child. The new words will be tested on the first Wednesday after half-term, **Wednesday 26th February.**
