## English:

We will continue to look at different figurative language (similes, metaphors, onomatopoeia etc.) to build into our poetry.

## Maths:

We will consolidate our learning of column method by using both addition and subtraction questions to practise the formal written method.

## Homework:

Homework this week comprises of an English and maths task alongside the usual TTrockstars, numbots, spelling and reading. This should be returned by Wednesday $13^{\text {th }}$ March. If, due to exceptional circumstances, it is likely to be late, please let us know as soon as possible. Golden points will be awarded for regular and strong activity on TTrockstars and Numbots. Please allow your child $\mathbf{1 0} \mathbf{~ m i n s}$ on both at least twice a week to reinforce their multiplication tables number facts.
Your child should be reading regularly each night at home. Please encourage at least 5 times a week and when possible, read with an adult so they can answer questions around what they've read. 2

## Spellings:

On Wednesday $13^{\text {th }}$ March most children will be tested on words with the short /u/spelt ou words: young, touch, double, trouble, country, courage, rough, tough, cousin, enough.
New spellings for the week Wednesday $13^{\text {th }}$ March which will be tested the following to Wednesday $20^{\text {th }}$ words are words adding suffixes beginning with a vowel (er, ed, ing) to words with more than one syllable such as: gardener, gardening, limited, limiting, offering, offered, benefited, benefitting, focused, focusing. Please remember to use a 'look, say, cover, write check, correct' approach for learning the spellings and to use the words in sentences. It is important to practise spellings daily so that they become embedded in long term memory.
