English:

New spellings will be sent home on Tuesday 12th December. The new words will be the Star Colour spellings specific to your child. They will be tested on the first Wednesday back after the Christmas holiday (Wednesday 10th January).

Please remember to use a 'look, say, cover, write check, correct' approach for learning the spellings and to use the words in sentences. It is important to practise spellings daily so that they become embedded in long term memory.
