This week in Year 3

English:

In English, we will continue to learn about non-chronological reports and explore the different language styles they use. We will begin to use all the facts we researched before Easter to start to layout our report.

Maths:

In Maths, we will start to look at statistics and data before representing them in different charts including bar charts, pictograms and two-way tables.

Homework:

READING: We are asking that at least ten minutes every day (5 times at least) is spent reading your child's **school colour band book** which then needs to be written in and signed by a parent in their reading diary. The children will read a leisure book (from the library) in school but must have their reading book and diary in school every day. The children are allowed to change their own reading book when needed, however it must have been **read at home and signed by an adult**. They are welcome to read their own books at home but must read their schoolbook in addition as golden points will be rewarded for schoolbooks only. You do not need to record any other reading in their diary except their schoolbook.

MATHS: 5-10 minutes times tables and number bond practice using TTrackstars and Numbots every day (3 times at least).

SPELLING: These will continue as usual and will be sent home on Mondays and tested the following Monday.

Spellings: This week the focus is to add the suffixes er/ed/ing to multisyllabic words with an unstressed last syllable (do not double the final consonant). The words the children need to learn are: **gardener, gardening, focused, focusing, offering, offered, benefited, benefiting, limited, limiting**. They will be tested on this list of words on **Monday 20th April**. Children in our class are given different spellings so if they lose their list, please ask an adult from the Yr 3 team and we will happily provide you with a new list.

Other Matters:

- PE will take place on **Thursdays and Fridays** this term. The children are asked to come dressed in their PE kits on those days. Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather, has a water bottle in school on those days and has suitable trainers.
- Please make sure your child's pencil case is replenished and named with a couple of writing pencils, small ruler, a whiteboard pen and a glue stick ready for the new term.
- Our pbone lessons will continue this Friday (17th) so please ensure your child remembers to bring their instrument with them to school that day.
- A letter was sent home on the last day of term regarding homework. Please keep it at home to refer to what activities you can challenge your child with.
- The children were given a copy of our class Poem we will be sharing at the Church service. They do not need to learn it by heart but have hopefully familiarised themselves with it over the Easter holidays.
- The Easter service at Holy Trinity Church on Thursday 16th April from 9:30am. Please do join us for this.
