This week in Year 3

English:

In English, we are beginning to build on an alternative version of Jim and the beanstalk which we have been studying this week.

Maths:

This week we will be adding and subtracting in 1s, 10s and 100s across tens numbers. Using our number bond knowledge and partitioning, we will make jumps to reach the total. We will use written methods to help show our working out and understanding of what we have done.

Homework:

Homework this week consists of one English and one maths piece of work. For the English homework, there is an activity to complete which uses fronted adverbials and the punctuation needed when writing them. In maths, the sheet reinforces skills we've used in class. One activity is spotting patterns in adding 1s, 10s and 100s without crossing the 10s. The other activity uses written methods to show how we add 1s across a 10.

Children in our class are given different worksheets for English and Maths, so if they need another, please ask an adult from the Yr 3 team and we will happily provide you with the correct work.

Please make sure all homework is handed in by **Wednesday 15th October**. If, due to exceptional circumstances, this homework is likely to be late, please let us know as soon as possible.

Please allow time for reading; at least ten minutes every day (5 times at least) and 5-10 minutes times tables and number bond practice using TTrockstars and Numbots will help your child's daily routine.

Reading diaries are collected in and checked on a Friday and golden points are awarded for children that have read 5x a week and had their diary signed.

Spellings:

This week the tricks/ patterns needed to help learn the words focus on the 'long o' sound. The list of words to learn are; throat, croak, below, tomorrow, hero, stroke, phone, toast, potatoes*, suppose. They will be tested on this list of words next **Monday 20th October**. Children in our class are given different spellings so if they lose their list, please ask an adult from the Yr 3 team and we will happily provide you with a new list.

Other Matters:
