This week in Year 3

English:

In English, we are beginning to look at adverts and the language used to persuade and engage the reader or listener.

Maths:

In Maths, we will continue our unit about 'Time'. Please have conversations with your child about Time in particular; different types of clocks (analogue and digit), recognising the difference between the hour hand and minute hand on an analogue clock. Use analogue clocks to ask what the time is or what time will it be in ... minutes. We have been looking at time to 5minutes but will move to the nearest 1min

Homework:

READING: We ask that at least ten minutes every day (5 times at least) is spent reading your child's **school colour band book** which then needs to be written in and **signed by a parent in their reading diary**. The children will read a leisure book (from the library) in school or at home but must have their reading book and diary in school every day. The children are allowed to change their own reading book when needed, however it must have been **read at home and signed by an adult**. Golden points will be rewarded for schoolbooks only. You do not need to record any other reading in their diary except their schoolbook.

MATHS: 5-10 minutes times tables and number bond practice using TTrockstars and Numbots every day (3 times at least).

SPELLING: These will continue as usual and will be sent home on Mondays and tested the following Monday.

Spellings: This week the focus is learn the key Year 3 and Year 4 statutory words: **breathe***, **centre***, **circle***, **knowledge***, **opposite***, **pressure***, **purpose***, **sentence***, **separate***, **therefore*** (*statutory words) They will be tested on this list of words on **Monday 22nd June**. Children in our class are given different spellings so if they lose their list, please ask an adult from the Yr 3 team and we will happily provide you with a new list.

Other Matters:

- PE this half term is on a **Wednesday and Friday**.
- Year 3 have been given an opportunity to further explore their Geography topic about Earthquakes and Volcanoes with an interactive workshop coming to school on Weds 24th June. A letter was sent home about it on Friday so please check your child's school bag and complete the payment Scopay no later than Weds 17th June.
