# This week in Year 3

# Monday 16<sup>th</sup> September 2024

#### English:

This week we will be continuing with our unit on instructions. We will practise giving instructions and then we will look at some grammar aspects, prepositions and adverbs, and their role in making instructions clear and precise.

#### Maths:

We will continue to consolidate our Y2 learning on numbers to 100. We will focus on placing numbers on a number line and, learn and use the key fact that there are 10 tens in a hundred. Later in the week, we will be comparing lengths and converting and finding equivalent measures from mm to cm or cm to mm.

#### Spellings:

The first spellings will be sent home this week on **Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> September** with the first spellings being 10 Y3 non-negotiable spellings that every child should be secure with (could, would, many, which, how, like, also, before, after and next). The routine will be that spellings are sent home on **Wednesdays** and children are tested the following **Wednesday**.

## Homework:

The first homework will be sent home this week on **Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September**. The routine will be that homework is sent out on **Friday** and needs to be returned to school by the following **Wednesday**. Homework will consist of an English activity, a Maths activity and Spellings.
