## This week in Year 3

### Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2026

#### **English:**

In English, we will be using the story of The Gruffalo to write our own play scripts.

#### **Maths:**

In Maths, we will continue to work on our unit about shape focusing on comparing and drawing angles.

#### **Homework:**

**READING:** We are asking that at least ten minutes every day (5 times at least) is spent reading your child's **school colour band book** which then needs to be written in and signed by a parent in their reading diary. The children will read a leisure book (from the library) in school but must have their reading book and diary in school every day. The children are allowed to change their own reading book when needed, however it must have been **read at home and signed by an adult**. They are welcome to read their own books at home but must read their schoolbook in addition as golden points will be rewarded for schoolbooks only. You do not need to record any other reading in their diary except their schoolbook.

**MATHS:** 5-10 minutes times tables and number bond practice using TTrackstars and Numbots every day (3 times at least).

**SPELLING:** These will continue as usual and will be sent home on Mondays and tested the following Monday.

**Spellings:** This week the focus is to identify and use words ending in /chuh/ spelt ture: **creature, picture, nature, furniture, capture, culture, moisture, future, texture, adventure**

They will be tested on this list of words **after half term on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June**. Children in our class are given different spellings so if they lose their list, please ask an adult from the Yr 3 team and we will happily provide you with a new list.

#### **Other Matters:**

- On Tuesday (19<sup>th</sup> May) children will need to come to school in their PE kits as we are going to a cricket festival at WBS in the afternoon. Please make sure your permission slip has been handed in to the office. We will still have PE as usual on Thursday and Friday.
- Pbones will continue Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> May so please ensure your child has their instrument in school that day.
- After half term Year 3 will begin their sewing project. Your child will need to bring in a scrap piece of material (about A4 paper size) or an old t-shirt to practise on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June.
