This week in Year 3

Monday 18th November 2024

English: We will continue to learn about inverted commas and direct speech.

Maths: In our addition and subtraction unit, we will be adding and subtracting multiples of a hundred to or from any 3-digit number and learning to spot the pattern when we add 1s, multiples of 10 or multiples of a 100 to a 3-digit number. We will also practice adding 1s to a 3-digit number crossing a 10. e.g $384 + 7$
At the end of the week, we will begin to look at dividing by sharing and using our multiplication tables as the inverse. We will also begin to learn our 3x table.

Homework:

As usual homework went out on Friday and comprised an English and maths activity. This homework should be handed in on **Wednesday 20th November**. If, due to exceptional circumstances, any homework is likely to be late, please let us know as soon as possible. Ten minutes reading and 5-10 minutes times tables and number bond practice should also form part of your child's daily routine.

Spellings:

In the test on **Wednesday 20th November**, most children will be tested on words with the dis- prefix (dis- is added to the root word to give it the opposite meaning): disappoint, disagree, disobey, disappear, dislike, discover, disbelieve, disallow, dishonest, disapprove. Some children have different lists

New spellings will be sent out after the test. For most children these will be words with the mis- prefix (mis- changes the meaning of the root word to mean incorrect or wrong): misuse, misread, mislead, mistrust, misspell, misbehave, misplace, misheard, misprint, miscommunicate plus the word Tuesday. The new spellings will be tested on **Wednesday 27th November**.

Other Matters:

- On Tuesday afternoon, Year 3 will be visiting Eton College's Museum of Antiquities to support our work on the Ancient Egyptians. We will have an early lunch at school and then walk there. We expect to be back at school for the normal collection time. Please make sure your child is wearing a warm waterproof coat.
- At the time of writing, we are still looking for one further parent volunteer to assist on this trip. If you are able to help, please contact the school office.
