This week in Year 3

Monday 21st October 2024

English: We will continue to look at features of Legends and, with a focus on the evil character, we will write a character description.

Maths: In our place value unit, we will consolidate our learning on estimating the position of numbers on number lines to 1000. We will then begin to compare 3 digits number by looking at the highest place value first.

Spellings:

In the test on **Wednesday 21st October** most children will be tested on words from the Y3/4 National Curriculum list: often, arrive, height, group, appear, women, describe, believe, breath, continue. Some children will be tested on a shorter easier list of words.

New spellings will be sent out after the test. These will be Star Colour spellings which are specific to your child. The new spellings will be tested on **Wednesday 16th October**.

Homework:

Homework given out on Friday comprised some grammar work on verbs in English along with a maths sheet on hundreds, tens and ones and number lines to 1000. The homework should be handed in on **Wednesday 23rd October**. If, due to exceptional circumstances, it is likely to be late, please let us know as soon as possible. Ten minutes reading and 5-10minutes times tables and number bond practice should also form part of your child's daily routine.

Other Matters:

- We will be making our pneumatic rainforest animals. All children will work with a partner and we display the finished products in school. Because the work is shared work with children using school equipment, children will not take their finished models home. We will, however, celebrate our work and every child will have a photo of their model as a keepsake.
- On Thursday, we will be visiting the Gurdwara in Slough to share some Sikh traditions which we have been learning about in our RE topic. Please read the email regarding the trip which refers to what the children will need.
