This week in Year 3

Monday 22nd September 2025

English:

This week, we are continuing our writing instruction unit. We have identified some of the key features needed to write instructions so will begin to apply them to a task.

Maths:

We are continuing our place value work and will be moving on to 1 more, 10 more, 100 more and using a number line to place numbers up to 1000.

Homework:

Homework this week consists of one English and one maths piece of work. The English task uses some of the features of instructions ready for us to be writing our own next week. The maths task requires the children to recognise, write and partition hundreds, tens and ones in a number.

Children in our class are given different worksheets for English and Maths, so if they need another, please ask an adult from the Yr 3 team and we will happily provide you with the correct work.

Please make sure all homework is handed in by **Wednesday 24th September**. If, due to exceptional circumstances, this homework is likely to be late, please let us know as soon as possible.

Please allow time for reading; at least ten minutes every day (5 times at least) and 5-10 minutes times tables and number bond practice using TTrockstars and Numbots will help your child's daily routine.

Reading diaries are collected in and checked on a Friday and golden points are awarded for children that have read 5x a week and had their diary signed.

Spellings:

We are following a new spelling scheme called Superhero Spellings which cover spelling patterns the children need to learn in Year 3. Children will be given a list of words from this scheme on Monday and will review the tricks/ patterns needed to help learn the spelling in their lesson. This week the focus is on the 'long a' sound which includes the words shake, afraid, train, great, display, delay, complain, escape, strange and straight. They will be tested on this list of words next **Monday 29th September**. Children in our class are given different spellings so if they lose their list, please ask an adult from the Yr 3 team and we will happily provide you with a new list.

Other Matters:

- Please could you save and bring in any egg cartons for **6 eggs** as we will be using them in our DT project next week (Mon 29th September). If you are able to bring in more than one egg box that would be a big help but please only boxes of 6.
- We had our first pbone lesson on Friday (19th) which the children enjoyed and have learnt how to look after and play their instrument. There is a letter explaining the hire and payment for the lessons which is in your child's homework folder. They will need to return this form to school before they can take their pbone home. Payments can be made on scopay. Due to a shortage of space, we are unable to store any instruments at school.
- Don't forget we have our **Year 3 Welcome meeting on Tuesday 23rd September at 9:00 – 9:30am**. Once you have dropped off your child you can head to the front office to sign in and wait to be shown to our classroom. I look forward to meeting you all then.
