This week in Year 3

Monday 23rd June 2025

English: We will begin some work on Fairytales and will start by reading Jim and the Beanstalk by Raymond Briggs, a variation of the classic tale, Jack and the Beanstalk.

Maths: We will start to look at telling the time on a digital clock.
Later in the week we will continue to work on fractions and begin to build on fractions of an amount.

Homework:

The homework handed out on Friday consisted of some story writing with an emphasis on using capital letters and full stops correctly. A Maths activity involving telling the time to the minute on an analogue clock accompanied this. The homework is due in on **Wednesday 25th June**. If, due to exceptional circumstances, this homework is likely to be late, please let us know as soon as possible. 10 minutes reading and 5-10 minutes times tables and number bond practice should also form part of your child's daily routine.

Spellings:

In the test on **Wednesday 25th June**, **most** children will be tested on words with the /sh/ sound spelt ch: chef, chalet, machine, brochure, chute, parachute, chauffeur, moustache, charades, champagne.

New spellings will be sent out on Wednesday after the test. The new words will be Words ending /g/ spelt gue and words with a /k/ spelt que: dialogue, league, tongue, plague, vague, antique, unique, mosque, technique, picturesque. The new words will be tested on **Wednesday 2nd July**.

Other Matters:

- On Monday, we are having a themed day based on the NSPCC's Speak out, Stay Safe programme. The day will comprise a PSHE lesson following an NSPCC plan and a variety of activities to follow including roleplay, some writing and some artwork.
