English:

In English, we are beginning to look at poetry and the features involved in different poetry styles.

Maths:

This week we are making compliments to 100 and making good estimates to different calculations by recognising the nearest multiple of 10 or 100.

Homework:

Homework this week consists of one English and one maths piece of work. The English worksheet is an editing task.

The maths worksheet, uses column addition and column subtraction with exchange.

Please allow time for reading; at least ten minutes every day (5 times at least) and 5-10 minutes times tables and number bond practice using TTrockstars and Numbots.

Reading diaries are collected in and checked on a Friday and golden points are awarded for children that have at least read 5x a week and had their diary signed.

Please feel free to read your own reading books at home. The school books are set at your child's level so please read those often but enjoy a range of genres and stories together as part of your daily routine.

Spellings:

This week the tricks/ patterns needed to help learn the words focus on making adverbs using the suffix – ly. The list of words to learn are; quickly, rudely, sweetly, bravely, secretly, angrily, lazily, busily, wearily, clumsily. They will be tested on this list of words next Monday 1st December. Children in our class are given different spellings so if they lose their list, please ask an adult from the Yr 3 team and we will happily provide you with a new list.
