English:

This week we will plan the paragraphs for our own version of Jack and the Beanstalk.

Maths:

It may help your child to begin to learn the rhyme: 30 days has September, April, June and November, All the rest have 31, Except February, 28 days here. Or 29 in each leap year.

Spellings

<u>In the Spelling Test on Wednesday 19th June</u> most children will be tested on words with /sh/ spelt ch: chef, chalet, machine, brochure, chute, parachute, chauffeur. moustache, charades, champagne

<u>New spellings</u> will be sent out on Thursday due to the Hexagon Concert on Wednesday. The new words will be words ending /g/ spelt gue and words with the /k/ spelt que: league, tongue, plague, vague, dialogue, antique, unique, mosque, technique, picturesque

Homework

Homework this week is to learn the words and practice the songs for the Hexagon concert. Many children are still not certain of the words and the concert is next week.

Please also try to do the usual ten minutes reading and 5-10minutes times tables and number bond practice.
