This week in Year 3

English: We will be learning about a new legend. We will then practice retelling our own version orally before beginning to write this including our new learning on sentences with subordinate clauses and direct speech.

Maths: In our addition and subtraction unit, we will be adding 1s across a 10 and 10s across a hundred when adding to a 3-digit number. e.g $384 + 7$ and $384 + 40$.

Homework:

As usual homework went out on Friday and comprised an English and maths activity. This homework should be handed in on **Wednesday 27th November**. If, due to exceptional circumstances, any homework is likely to be late, please let us know as soon as possible. Ten minutes reading and 5-10 minutes times tables and number bond practice should also form part of your child's daily routine.

Spellings:

In the test on **Wednesday 27th November**, most children will be tested on words with mis- prefix (mis- changes the meaning of the root word to mean incorrect or wrong): misuse, misread, mislead, mistrust, misspell, misbehave, misplace, misheard, misprint, miscommunicate plus the word Tuesday. Some children have different lists.

New spellings will be sent out after the test. For most children these will be words with the re- prefix (re - added to the root word means to repeat or to do the action again): reapply, rewrite, return, reappear, replace, repay, rebuild, revisit, reread, revisit plus the word December. The new spellings will be tested on **Wednesday 4th December**.

Other Matters:

- We thoroughly enjoyed our trip to Eton College's Museum of Antiquities last week. The children learned more about the process of mummification, about hieroglyphics and about the Ancient Egyptian gods. Many apologies for our late arrival back at school.
- Please could you make sure that your child has a reasonable stock of writing pencils and at least one white board pen? An increasing number of children are needing to borrow these items. New white board pens can be bought from the school office at a cost of £1.
