## This week in Year 3

## Monday 26th February 2024

## English:

We have started to look at narrative poems and are beginning to recognise the different features used. This week, we will explore the different language and layouts and how the writing differs from regular story telling.

## Maths:

We have started to use column addition as a formal written method where we can exchange into the next column. This week we will apply this method when using subtraction and use the poem 'more on the floor then you go next door' to help us exchange when the digit below is bigger than the top.

## Homework:

This week's homework consists of a maths piece using column addition and English which looks at the language and layout of a poem in preparation for our classwork. This should be returned by Wednesday $\mathbf{2 1}^{\text {st }}$ February. If, due to exceptional circumstances, it is likely to be late, please let us know as soon as possible.

Golden points will be awarded for regular and strong activity on TTrockstars and Numbots. Please allow your child $\mathbf{1 0}$ mins on both at least twice a week to reinforce their multiplication tables number facts. Your child should be reading regularly each night at home. Please encourage at least 5 times a week and when possible, read with an adult so they can answer questions around what they've read. 2

## Spellings:

On Wednesday $28^{\text {th }}$ February most children will be tested on some common exception words which don't follow a regular pattern; length, strength, purpose, history, different, difficult, separate, suppose, therefore and knowledge.
New spellings will be sent home on Thursday $29^{\text {th }}$ Feb following the test. The new words will be from the Y3/4 National Curriculum list of spellings. The list will comprise the following words: happily, angrily, lazily, easily, greedily, messily, cheekily, sleepily and noisily. Please remember to use a 'look, say, cover, write check, correct' approach for learning the spellings and to use the words in sentences. It is important to practise spellings daily so that they become embedded in long term memory

## Other Matters:

- On Monday, we are visiting the Chertsey Museum to explore aspects of Ancient Greek life and culture. Please remember we will leave school at 8:45am so please arrive at 8:40 promptly. If, on the way home, we experience traffic delays we will text you however we hope to be back for 3:15.
