This week in Year 3

English:

In English, have started to look at Haiku's, a Japanese style of poetry. We will continue to look at the features before writing our own.

Maths:

In Maths, we are moving on to our second fraction unit where we will be adding and subtracting fractions.

Homework:

READING: We are asking that at least ten minutes every day (5 times at least) is spent reading your child's **school colour band book** which then needs to be written in and signed by a parent in their reading diary. The children will read a leisure book (from the library) in school but must have their reading book and diary in school every day. The children are allowed to change their own reading book when needed, however it must have been **read at home and signed by an adult**. They are welcome to read their own books at home but must read their schoolbook in addition as golden points will be rewarded for schoolbooks only. You do not need to record any other reading in their diary except their schoolbook.

MATHS: 5-10 minutes times tables and number bond practice using TTrackstars and Numbots every day (3 times at least).

SPELLING: These will continue as usual and will be sent home on Mondays and tested the following Monday.

Spellings: This week the focus is to learn the key Year 3 and Year 4 statutory words*. The words the children need to learn are: **consider*, quarter*, remember*, answer*, appear*, early*, earth*, heard*, heart*, learn***

They will be tested on this list of words on **Monday 4th May**. Children in our class are given different spellings so if they lose their list, please ask an adult from the Yr 3 team and we will happily provide you with a new list.

Other Matters:

- PE will take place on **Thursdays and Fridays** this term. The children are asked to come dressed in their PE kits on those days. Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather, has a water bottle in school on those days and has suitable trainers.
- Dates for the diary; The school's sponsored run is to take place on Thursday 7th May. Please look out for the sponsor forms from the TSSSA in due course.
- Mrs Avramovic sent out an email this week asking the children to bring in a piece of fabric (approx. the size of an A4 sheet of paper) from an old t-shirt/ pillowcase etc to help practise sewing. This needs to be brought in to school by Monday 1st June.
