This week in Year 3

English:

This week, we will be writing our version of instructions. We have identified lots of the key features through our classwork so we will be able to apply them to our work.

Maths:

We are moving into our addition and subtraction unit this week. Our focus will begin with securing our number bonds to 10 to help us do this at different stages.

Homework:

Homework this week consists of one English and one maths piece of work. The English is a reading comprehension task with an instruction writing theme. The maths task continues to work around place value and 1, 10 or 100 more or less and missing numbers on a number line.

Children in our class are given different worksheets for English and Maths, so if they need another, please ask an adult from the Yr 3 team and we will happily provide you with the correct work.

Please make sure all homework is handed in by **Wednesday 1st October**. If, due to exceptional circumstances, this homework is likely to be late, please let us know as soon as possible.

Please allow time for reading; at least ten minutes every day (5 times at least) and 5-10 minutes times tables and number bond practice using TTrockstars and Numbots will help your child's daily routine.

Reading diaries are collected in and checked on a Friday and golden points are awarded for children that have read 5x a week and had their diary signed.

Spellings:

This week the tricks/ patterns needed to help learn the words focus on the 'long e' sound. The list of words to learn are; agree, cheese, increase, peace, sequel, complete, extreme, believe, piece, recent. They will be tested on this list of words next **Monday 6th October**. Children in our class are given different spellings so if they lose their list, please ask an adult from the Yr 3 team and we will happily provide you with a new list.

Other Matters:

- Please could you save and bring in any egg cartons for **6 eggs** as we will be using them in our DT project next week (Mon 29th September). If you are able to bring in more than one egg box that would be a big help but please only boxes of 6.
- We have sent home pphones with some of the children today. For your child to receive the instrument lesson and so they can take their instrument home we need the payment and form to be completed. Payments can be made on scopay. Due to a shortage of space, we are unable to store any instruments at school.
