English:

We will continue to explore playscripts. This week we will begin to write our own playscripts using the Gruffalo as a stimulus.

Maths:

In our fractions unit we will be comparing non-unit fractions and then move onto using fractions on a scale. Examples of this include weighing scales and the scales on measuring jugs. At the end of the week, we will be continuing to measure accurately in millimetres, centimetres and metres.

Spellings

In the Spelling Test on Wednesday 1st May most children will be tested on words ending /zher/ spelt sure: measure, treasure, pleasure, enclosure, leisure, pressure, closure, unsure.

Homework

Homework given out on Friday comprised some word and sentence work in English along with a maths sheet. The homework should be handed in on Wednesday 1st May.

There are two tasks which comprise of English; using the homophone their, there and they're and maths; measuring in cm and mm.

If, due to exceptional circumstances, it is likely to be late, please let us know as soon as possible. Ten minutes reading and 5-10minutes times tables and number bond practice should also form part of your child's daily routine.
