## English:

This week within our unit on Legends we will be working on using subordinate clauses to create complex sentences.

## Maths:

Please remember to use a 'look, say, cover, write check, correct' approach for learning the spellings and to use the spellings in sentences. Remember, it is important to practise spellings daily so that they become embedded in long term memory.
