This week in Year 3

Monday 4th December 2023

English:

We will start writing a legend including all the new grammar and punctuation that we have learned this term. We will use subordinate clauses, direct speech and ambitious verbs, adverbs and adjectives.

Maths:

This week we will consolidate our learning on adding and subtracting mentally a 3-digit number and ones, tens or hundreds. A particular focus will be spotting the pattern.

With Mrs Foster, we are continuing to work on our 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables spotting patterns in the numbers and developing our rapid recall of these.

Homework:

The homework to be sent home on Friday will be the usual English and Maths activities. It should be returned to school by the following **Wednesday.** If, due to exceptional circumstances, it is likely to be late, please let us know as soon as possible. New spellings will be sent home on Wednesday 6th December and will be tested the following week on the 13th December. Ten minutes reading and 5-10minutes times tables practice should also form part of your child's daily routine.

Spellings:

<u>This week's spellings to be tested on Wednesday</u> are the words: redo, reuse, replay, rewrite, return, reappear, replace rebuild, revisit, recycle, which.

<u>New spellings</u> will be sent home on Wednesday 6th December following the test. The new words will be from the Y3/4 National Curriculum list of spellings. The list will comprise the following words: busy, fruit, address, complete, business, heart, breathe, strange, extreme and forwards.

Please remember to use a 'look, say, cover, write check, correct' approach for learning the spellings and to use the words in sentences. It is important to practise spellings daily so that they become embedded in long term memory.

Other Matters:

- We thoroughly enjoyed our trip to Eton College Museum of Antiquities last week to enrich our Ancient Egyptians topic. Many apologies for our late arrival back at school. Because the children were tired and our route was busier than on the outward journey, the walk took much longer than anticipated.
- This week we have a road safety session on Tuesday afternoon.
