This week in Year 3

Monday 5th May 2025

English: We have started a new unit on playscripts. This week we will focus on the features of playscripts and how playscripts are different to story books.

Maths: We will be dividing a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number using partitioning. We will start with numbers that can be divided easily when partitioned into their tens and ones. Time permitting, we will begin to look at numbers that need more flexible partitioning.
At the end of the week we will continue to build on our fractions work.

Homework:

The homework handed out on Friday consisted of work to create either a rhyming poem or a rhyming sentence. There was no new Maths Homework following the extension of the deadline for the maths homework sent out last week. Last week's Maths Homework and the new English Homework are both due in on **Wednesday 7th May**. If, due to exceptional circumstances, this homework is likely to be late, please let us know as soon as possible. 10 minutes reading and 5-10 minutes times tables and number bond practice should also form part of your child's daily routine.

Spellings:

In the test on **Wednesday 7th May**, most children will be tested on words ending /zher/ spelt sure: sure, unsure, measure, treasure, pleasure, pressure, leisure, closure, enclosure plus the word sculpture.

New spellings will be sent out on Wednesday after the test. For most children these will be words ending /cher/ spelt ture: creature, picture, nature, adventure, future, mixture, fixture, temperature, sculpture, structure. The new words will be tested on **Wednesday 14th May**.

Other Matters:

Those who came reported that it was a useful session and would help them to support their child in maths at home. We have been asked to make our presentation available to parents and we are looking at the best way to do this.
