This week in Year 3

Monday 6th October 2025

English:

This week, we will begin our next unit which looks at fairy stories. We look at some familiar stories and their features.

Maths:

This week we will be adding and subtracting in 1s, 10s and 100s and looking at which place value columns change before adding and subtracting across the next place value column.

Homework:

Homework this week consists of one English and one maths piece of work. The English is in preparation for our fairy stories unit and focuses on adjectives and exciting vocabulary which hopefully they can then use. In maths, the children have been given worksheets using number bonds and adding and subtracting in 1s and 10s to practice.

Children in our class are given different worksheets for English and Maths, so if they need another, please ask an adult from the Yr 3 team and we will happily provide you with the correct work.

Please make sure all homework is handed in by **Wednesday 8th October**. If, due to exceptional circumstances, this homework is likely to be late, please let us know as soon as possible.

Please allow time for reading; at least ten minutes every day (5 times at least) and 5-10 minutes times tables and number bond practice using TTrockstars and Numbots will help your child's daily routine.

Reading diaries are collected in and checked on a Friday and golden points are awarded for children that have read 5x a week and had their diary signed.

Spellings:

This week the tricks/ patterns needed to help learn the words focus on the 'long i' sound. The list of words to learn are; reply, describe, guide, surprise, exercise, island, bicycle, library, fright and height. They will be tested on this list of words next **Monday 13th October**. Children in our class are given different spellings so if they lose their list, please ask an adult from the Yr 3 team and we will happily provide you with a new list.

Other Matters:
