#### **English:**

In English, we will continue to use descriptive language to write our own poems.

This week the tricks/ patterns needed to help learn the words focus on commas for contractions are: wasn't, hasn't, wouldn't, shouldn't, couldn't, doesn't, didn't, l'm, l'll, it's. They will be tested on this list of words next Monday 15<sup>th</sup> December. This will be their last spelling test for the term. Children in our class are given different spellings so if they lose their list, please ask an adult from the Yr 3 team and we will happily provide you with a new list.
