This week in Year 3

English: We will complete writing our version of a Greek Legend. We will also listen to the legends that children have been practicing as a homework task.

Maths: We will consolidate our learning on adding 10s across a hundred when adding to a 3-digit number and start to apply the strategies we have learnt in some problem solving. At the end of the week, we will continue to learn the 4x table with the inverse.

Homework:

On Friday, children took home a maths sheet to practise adding 1s across a 10 and 10s across a 100. There was no new English homework, as the children had, last week, been given 2 weeks to research and rehearse retelling a legend of their choice to share with the class on **Wednesday 11th December**. The maths homework should also be handed in on **Wednesday 11th December**. This is the last homework of the term. If, due to exceptional circumstances, the homework is likely to be late, please let us know as soon as possible. Ten minutes reading and 5-10minutes times tables and number bond practice should also form part of your child's daily routine.

Spellings:

In the test on **Wednesday 4th December,** most children will be tested on words with from the National Curriculum Y3/4 list: address, busy, business, heart, fruit, breathe, strange, complete, extreme, forwards. Some children have different lists.

<u>New spellings</u> will be sent out after the test. These will be Star Colour Spellings which are specific to your child. The new spellings will be tested in the new term on **Wednesday 8**th **January**

Other Matters:

- Our Christmas celebrations are now in 'full throttle'. The Christmas lunch is on Wednesday and at 6pm on the same day KS1 will perform their Nativity play in St Stephen and St Agnes Church. On Thursday, the whole school will be going to see Dick Whittington at the Theatre Royal Windsor and, on Friday, it is of course the School Fair at 3.30pm.
