## This week in Year 4

**Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2026**

### English:

This week we will continue our unit, 'Myths and Legends'. This week the children will be writing their own Mythical story including their mythical creature they described last week. As this week is World Book Day, the children will be completing book related activities during the week.

### Maths:

This week we continue with our 'Multiplication and Division' unit. The children will be applying their written methods of multiplying and dividing to solve word problems and reasoning questions.

The children will also consolidate their understanding of correspondence problems from Year 3, using multiplication to work out the number of possible combinations of sets of items.

### Home Learning:

#### Spellings:

The focus this week: To understand and use words ending in **-ous** when there is a change to the root word. When a word ends in 'our' we change the 'our' to 'or'. When the word ends in 'y' we change the 'y' to 'i'.

The children will bring home their spellings on **Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> March** for their test on **Monday 9<sup>th</sup> March**.

Please ensure your child has their spelling book in school on a **Monday** so we can highlight any words spelt incorrectly in the spelling test and stick the new spellings in. The children's times table score is also recorded in the back of the spelling book.

#### Reading:

Please ensure your child is reading to an adult **daily** and they are being questioned about what they have read. Please record their reading in their reading record book. The children can change their books regularly if an adult has recorded in the book that they have read and finished the book. Children need to bring their reading book and reading record in to school every day.

#### Times Tables:

This week the children will be tested on the **9 times table** eg  $9 \times 1 = 9$ ,  $9 \times 2 = 18$ ,  $9 \times 3 = 27$ . They will be tested on **Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> March**.

**Children must be accessing Times Table Rock Stars at least 3 times a week** to help them to learn the times tables. In addition, children may also want to use [Multiplication Tables Check - Mathsframe](#) or [Times tables games - Learn them all here!](#)

In June, all the children will sit the Multiplication Tables Check. It is designed to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently up to 12, through a set of 25 timed questions. **It is important that children are practising their tables at home as well as at school.**

### Other Matters:

- The children will have their PE lesson on **Tuesdays and Fridays**, they will need to remember to come to school in their PE kit on those days.
- **Friday 6<sup>th</sup> March** - Word Book Day – come dressed up as your favourite book character.
- **On Monday's, in Computing the children will explore the features of effective audio books and work as a team to script, record and edit their own.** If they have any headphones that they can bring in to use in these lessons, we would be very grateful. Thank you.
