This week in Year 4

Monday 2nd June

English:

This week in English the children will be continuing their unit on Poetry. They will be planning their own poem based around some of the poems we have read last half term. The children will also be starting to rehearse our end of year production, 'Pirates and Mermaids'. The children came home with scripts and their part so please encourage them to learn their lines at home.

Spellings:

This week's spellings: Adding the prefix non- (meaning 'not'); non-stick, non-stop, non-starter, non-smoker, nonsense, non-fiction, non-drip, non-violent, non-profit, and non-believer. The children will receive their spellings on Monday 2nd June and will be tested on Monday 9th June. If your child has returned home with a different spelling list, please focus on those words and not the ones mentioned above.

Maths:

This week we continue our unit on Decimals. The children will learn to divide a 1-digit number by 10, resulting in a decimal number with 1 decimal place. They will recognise that when using a place value chart, they move all of the digits one place to the right when dividing by 10. The children will also be working on their recall of the times tables ready for the MTC, which will take place either at the end of this week or next week. Please continue learning them at home.

Homework:

Homework will be sent out on Wednesdays and needs to be returned to school by the following Monday. This week's homework will include a writing activity and a Maths activity. There will be further information given with regards to your child's homework on Wednesday.

Please continue to learn all the times tables up to 12 x 12 ready for the MTC.

Other Matters:

- Multiplication Tables Check 2nd to 13th June 2025.
- The children have brought home their scripts for the Year 4 production please help them learn their lines off by heart thank you. If any children have any pirate or mermaid costumes or accessories we could borrow, please can they bring them into school thank you.
- The children will have their PE lesson on Tuesdays and Fridays, they will need to remember to bring their PE kit in on those days. Please can all children have the correct PE kit in their bags thank you.
- Please encourage your child to read daily at home and sign their reading record. I have informed the children that I will be checking their reading records every Friday.
- Our class book is 'The Wild Robot' by Peter Brown. We are very lucky that we have a whole class set so each child gets to follow along as I read.
