This week in Year 4

Monday 3rd March – World Book Day Week

English:

This week our work will focus around the story, Hamlet. The children will be watching a performance of Hamlet by the *Young Shakespeare Company*. They will then be sequencing the story and describing the characters in the story along with other book week activities.

Spellings:

This week we will be learning the following spellings: centre, century, certain, recent, experience, sentence, notice, celebrate, ceremony and certificate. These are words with a 'soft c' spelt with 'ce'. The children will be tested on Monday 10th March. If your child has returned home with a different spelling list, please focus on those words and not the ones mentioned above.

Maths:

This week we will be continuing with our unit on 'Multiplication and Division'. The children will continue to develop their understanding of division by extending from dividing 2-digit numbers to dividing 3-digit numbers. Place value counters will be used to represent the calculations, so that the children can make sense of exchanges that are needed to complete the divisions.

Homework:

Homework will be sent out on Wednesdays and needs to be returned to school by the following Monday. I have spoken to the children about this and have suggested ways in which they can organise their time to ensure their homework is handed in on time. This week's homework will include an English activity and a Mathematics activity. There will be further information given with regards to your child's homework on Wednesday.

- World Book Day dressing up will be on Friday 7th March 2025.
- Science Week starts Monday 10th March 2025.
- The children will have their PE lesson on Mondays and Fridays, they will need to remember to bring their PE kit in on those days.
