This week in Year 4

Monday 3rd November

English:

This week we will continue our unit based around Harry Potter. The children will be looking at the rules of using inverted commas in direct speech. They will have the opportunity to punctuate dialogue and to write their own dialogue between different characters. They will work on extending the dialogue using adverbs.

Spellings:

Children will get their spelling words on **Wednesday 5th November** to learn for **Monday 10th November**. The children will be focusing on words with /aw/ spelt augh or au.

Maths:

This week we will continue our unit on 'Addition and Subtraction'. The children will be working on subtracting two 4-digit numbers with more than one exchange. Having explored both mental and written methods of subtraction in this unit, the children will then look at making choices about which method is most appropriate for a given calculation.

Homework:

Homework will be sent out on Wednesdays and needs to be returned to school by the following Monday. The children will come home on **Wednesday 5th November** with a new times table to learn for **Tuesday 11th November**. This week's timetable will be the 3 times table eg: 3×1 , 3×2 , 3×3 , 3×4 , 3×5 etc
