This week in Year 4

Monday 5th January 2026 – Happy New Year

English:

This week we will start our new unit, 'Myths and Legends' with a focus on legends of the sea. In this unit your child will listen to mythical stories of selkies and mermaids. They will then use captivating mythical stories of selkies and mermaids to write their own sea myths. We will focus on writing in paragraphs and punctuating dialogue in the correct way. We will be reading Selkie by Gillian McClure this week.

Spellings:

The focus this week is Homophones & Near Homophones. Children will bring home the spellings on **Wednesday 7th January** for the test on **Monday 12th January**.

Maths:

This week we will continue with our, 'Multiplication and Division' unit. Children bring together their knowledge of multiplying and dividing by 7, 11 and 12 in order to become more fluent in these times-tables. Children will construct fact families and use concrete and pictorial representations to make links between multiplication and division.

Times Tables

The children will come home on **Wednesday 7th January** with a new times table to learn for **Tuesday 13th January**. This week's times table will be **the 6x table** written and learnt as: $6 \times 1 = 6$, $6 \times 2 = 12$, $6 \times 3 = 24$ etc...
