English:

This week we will continue our unit based around Harry Potter. Maths:

This week we will continue our unit on Multiplication and Division. They will continue to embed their fluency skills with the 6 times-table, while also using strategies of using the multiplication facts they know to find unknown facts. They will then move on to the 9 times table.

As we are nearing our Christmas concert, the children need to be learning the songs and poems that I have sent home over the last couple of weeks. **Please ensure the children are learning these songs and poems.** There will not be a **new** times table to learn this week but please revise all the times tables we have done so far. This can be done by playing different games on TTRS.
