Monday 9th June

English:

This week in English the children will be continuing their unit on Poetry. After planning their own poem last week, the children will be editing and improving their poem. The children will also be continuing to rehearse our end of year production, 'Pirates and Mermaids'. The children came home with scripts and their part so please encourage them to learn their lines at home.

Maths:

This week we continue our unit on Decimals. The children will learn to divide 1-and 2-digit numbers by 100. They will build numbers using place value counters and use exchanges to support their understanding. Once confident working with place value counters, they will move to using place value charts and recognise that dividing a number by 100 moves all the counters two places to the right.

Homework:

Homework will be sent out on Wednesdays and needs to be returned to school by the following Monday. This week's homework will include continuing to learn their lines off by heart and the songs for our Year 4 production, and a Maths activity. There will be further information given with regards to your child's Maths homework on Wednesday.

Please continue to learn all the times tables up to 12 x 12 ready for the MTC which the children will complete this week.

Other Matters:

- Multiplication Tables Check the week of the 9th June 2025.
- The children have brought home their scripts for the Year 4 production please help them learn their lines off by heart thank you. If any children have any pirate or mermaid costumes or accessories we could borrow, please can they bring them into school thank you.
- The children will have their PE lesson on Tuesdays and Fridays, they will need to remember to bring their PE kit in on those days. Please can all children have the correct PE kit in their bags thank you.
- Please encourage your child to read daily at home and sign their reading record. I have informed the children that I will be checking their reading records every Friday.
