Monday 10th March – Science Week

English:

This week our work will focus around the book 'The Wolf's Story' by Toby Forward. The children will be predicting the story and then identifying and exploring the characters. They will be comparing it to the original version of Little Red Riding Hood and how wolves are portrayed in books.

Spellings:

This week we will be learning the following spellings: words with a 'soft c' spelt with 'ci'; circle, decide, medicine, exercise, cinema, decimal, accident, city. The children will be tested on Monday 17th March. If your child has returned home with a different spelling list, please focus on those words and not the ones mentioned above.

Maths:

This week we will be continuing with our unit on 'Multiplication and Division'. The children consolidate their knowledge and understanding of multiplication and begin to make decisions regarding the most efficient or appropriate methods to use in a range of contexts. We then move on to 'Length and Perimeter'. The children will explore perimeter with a focus on rectilinear shapes, where all sides meet at right angles.

Homework:

Homework will be sent out on Wednesdays and needs to be returned to school by the following Monday. I have spoken to the children about this and have suggested ways in which they can organise their time to ensure their homework is handed in on time. This week's homework will include an English activity and a Mathematics activity. There will be further information given with regards to your child's homework on Wednesday.

Other Matters:

- Science Week starts Monday 10th March 2025.
- The children will have their PE lesson on Mondays and Fridays, they will need to remember to bring their PE kit in on those days.
- Please encourage your child to read daily at home and sign their reading record, I have informed the children that I will be checking their reading records every Friday.
- Please encourage your child to access TTRS at least three times a week.
- Our class book is 'The Wild Robot' by Peter Brown. We are very lucky that we have a whole class set so each child gets to follow along as I read.
- The children have started learning some of the songs for The Hexagon. Please encourage your child to learn these songs at home. A letter was sent home with all the links to the songs and words.
