English:

This week we will start our new unit based around Harry Potter. The children will be looking at using powerful verbs and adverbs in their writing. We will then move on to looking at the different features of persuasive texts.

Spellings:

Children will get their spelling words on **Wednesday 15th October** to learn for **Monday 20th October**. The children will be focusing on the less common ways to spell the long O sound.

Maths:

This week we will continue our unit on 'Addition and subtraction'. The children will be adding two 4-digit numbers with no exchange and then working up to adding, where there is more than one exchange. The children will make the numbers using place value counters in a place value chart alongside the formal written method.

Homework:

Homework will be sent out on Wednesdays and needs to be returned to school by the following Monday. This week's homework will include an English activity and a Mathematics activity.

The children will come home on Wednesday 15th October with a new times table to learn for Tuesday 21st October. Please can the children continue to learn our Harvest song – 'Lets Harvest' (all children have been given a copy).
